Give a Girl a Chance, a Feminenza programme (www.feminenza.org), provides **financial assistance** to help pay for their **education, rehabilitation, mentoring** and **development**. The focus this coming year is Africa's Great Lakes Region (Sudan, Somalia, Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, Congo, Tanzania). The girls, upon completion of their education, will contribute to the fund, making it self-sustaining.
